Direct School Admission (DSA)



Direct School Admission (DSA-Sec)

- DSA-Sec provides **all** Primary 6 students with an **opportunity** to go into a secondary school of their choice, based on their non-academic achievements, talents and/or academic achievements. There are different DSA-Sec Categories e.g Talent-specific.
- DSA-Sec allows students to grow their **talents** through the school programmes offered.
- Each participating school offers <u>distinctive programme</u> and sets its own selection process and criteria to admit students with talents that can be further developed by their programmes.

Should My Child Apply For DSA-SEC

• You may consider applying for your child a secondary school through DSA-Sec if you are able to identify a school that offers a talent development programme to help **develop** your child's area of strength.

• If not, your child can participate in the Sec One Posting Exercise after the PSLE results release and be admitted to a secondary school **based on his/her PSLE results**.

DSA Schools Selection

When selecting a DSA-Sec school, consider the following:

Schools with talent areas that match:

- strengths and interests
- pace of learning
- the overall range of programmes offered by the school

List of Talent Areas For DSA-Sec





Your child can apply for DSA-Sec based on a wide-range of talents, including:

- Sports and games
- Visual, literary and performing arts
- Debate and public speaking
- Science, mathematics and engineering
- Languages and humanities
- Uniformed groups
- Leadership (for example, prefects, CCA Leaders)



DSA-SEC Application Process

- Parents are to submit the application <u>online</u> via the <u>DSA-Sec Portal</u> <u>between May 2025 to June 2025</u>. Either parent may log in using SingPass to submit an application. If parents are unable to apply online, you may approach the school for assistance.
- If your child is interested in **School of the Arts (SOTA)** or **Singapore Sports School (SSP)**, you should **apply directly** to the school based on the **school's application timeline**.
- You may visit the school's website for more information. You can indicate up to **three** choices during the application.
- There is **no** need to submit additional hardcopy testimonials and documents via the DSA-Sec Portal as the primary school information will be shared with the secondary schools that your child has applied to.

Application Outcomes



• You will be informed of the application outcome of your child by the individual schools by <u>September 2025</u>. If your child have a Confirmed Offer (CO) or a Wait List (WL) offer, you will receive notification on the School Preference Submission in <u>October 2025</u>.

- To gain admission, your child still need to attain PSLE results that qualify them for a course (i.e. Posting Group) offered by the school
- If your child has not been given a place in the DSA-Sec school, your child can still apply for a school through the **Sec One Posting Exercise** using his/her PSLE results.

Important points to note on DSA-Sec

 Students successfully allocated to their DSA-Sec schools will <u>NOT be allowed</u> to participate in the S1 Posting to opt for secondary schools.

• Students will also **NOT be allowed to transfer** to another school after the release of their PSLE results.

• If your child is not ready to commit, he/she should participate in the S1 Posting Exercise after the release of PSLE results.

You can apply for the Singpass online or you can come to school to do the online application for your child.

Can my child apply for only one school?

Yes, your child may apply for one school. However your child have **3 choices** as such your child may want to utilise the choices. Your child can choose more than 1 talent area in the same school or 3 schools with same talent area in his/her application.




DSA Support@Xishan
